Dr. Moon suggested that the color beds be reduced by 70% and the use of permanent plantings as hydro-zoning is expensive. Mary Patrick made the suggestion that the main color beds at major entrances remain. The LMC's gave reports of the findings in their area and discussion was held with the committee and their questions

- Quail Creek Natural Area has wall by pond that is falling away. To avoid a liability with homeowners it was suggested this repair be done. Linda Rawlings made motion to complete the repair not to exceed \$60,000. Gary Lauman seconded, and the motion carried.
- 78 trees need to be removed and relocated along the Virginia medians due to over planting. Gary Lauman made motion for project to be done next Fall. Matt Swor seconded, and the motion carried.
