#### **New Business:**

## Eric Ortega:

- 2 ponds in Wellington have issues that need to be addressed. Pond 7 transfer pipe had a leaking elbow. Need to trench 6' around the edge, demo the spillway and redo the spillway. Eric will get numbers together for this pond as well as Pond 2.
- Fountainview has a leak at the spillway. More work to be done on well, already approved, and ready to be done. Pond also needs to be dredged.
- LaCima is still an ongoing situation with a sediment issue and City of McKinney will not give a time frame.
- The recent issue with dead fish was resulted in a high chlorine content and unsure as to how this occurred. Suggested to do an article about homeowners draining their pools.

- Lakes and ponds will now be handled by the Landscape & Grounds Committee.
- A new collection firm was hired.
- The current water budget is under budget.
- TXDot needs to acquire some land from Stonebridge Ranch for the Highway 380 project.
