- Color Bed Project Sections A & B will plant freeze tolerant plantings only at this time.
 Matthew tweaked Section A after inspecting and Section B is scheduled to be inspected.
- May need to see renderings of plants for Section C.
- Gary and Mathew looked at Bridgepoint. Some plants were cut because work needs to be done on monuments first.
- Mulch Reduction Plan Section C is currently in budget.
- Arbor Creek flood water going into homeowners back yard. Problem will be addressed.
- Dr. Moon's inspection reports need to be more detailed and done in SmartLink.
 Problems need to be flagged and results need to be reported each month. Committee needs to have full transparency.
- Operating budget for 2024 reported on. Will need all left-over money for last minute needs and should come out even.
- Wellington Point wall needs to be repaired. This is a City of McKinney problem that needs to be addressed so we can move ahead to do plants.
